Dear participant,

This is an invitation to participate in project RELI, a study that aims at investigating the language(s) and language varieties used by university students, alumni, and general public to see how their language use manifests in their day-to-day activities and interactions both in and outside the UAZ.

Your participation in the study is completely voluntary. If you wish to participate, you'll be asked to provide information through the following instruments:

**1) Electronic questionnaire-** go to the project's website <https://multilinguistizac.uaz.edu.mx> and click on 'Join the study'. You'll find a link to the questionnaire, where you'll be asked to provide personal information about the languages/varieties you speak/know and how you use them in your daily life. At the end of the questionnaire, you'll be asked to provide an email address to contact you and book an interview with the project's leader Dra. Alejandra Núñez.

**2) Interview (online/F2F)-** The interviews will take place online or face-to-face on the date and time of your preference. This activity will last between 30-40 min and you'll be asked questions related to the questionnaire's topic (language/varieties, common use, etc.).

**3) Samples-** When booking your interview, you'll be asked to provide photos, images (PDF, JPG) of class notes, personal objects (shirts, posters, memorabilia, books, etc.), places (home, office, school, city/town) where your daily use of languages/varieties is manifested. All the images will be carefully checked to avoid the display of personal information. You can send the images through email or hand them in person on the day of the interview or during the research process.

Your participation will be completely anonymous and confidential. If needed, participants will be identified with a pseudonym. The signed consent letters will be kept by the researchers in a safe place. The email you provide at the end of the questionnaire will only be used to contact you to book the interview.

At the end of the study, the results will be published on the website: <https://multilinguistizac.uaz.edu.mx> where they will be available permanently. Additionally, the results will be published in academic journals, and they might also be presented in national or international conferences. The links to all the publications will be found in the project's website.
